







New Canadian Transporter Requirements



Transporter Operating Authority

For Provincial Transport Only

- ✓ Proof of your active provincial registration for the province where your company is registered including your National Safety Code (NSC) or applicable provincial carrier safety fitness registration/certificate.
 - ✓ **AB Alberta** Commercial Vehicle Registration (CVR) Alberta Transportation
 - ✓ BC British Columbia Commercial Transport Permit (CVSE) British Columbia Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure
 - ✓ MB Manitoba Commercial Motor Vehicle Registration (CMV) Manitoba Public Insurance (MPI)
 - ✓ **NB New Brunswick** Commercial Vehicle Registration (CVR) Department of Public Safety

For Inter-Provincial Transport Across Multiple Jurisdictions

✓ In addition to your NSC and provincial registration, please include proof of International Registration Plan (IRP) for applicable provinces.

Your Transportation Authority must have a minimum of 30 documented days of experience as an authorized motor carrier for provincial or inter-provincial transportation.

Certificate of Insurance

- ✓ RunBuggy MUST be listed as ADDITIONAL INSURED on your certificate using the address below with these required coverages:

- ✓ Motor Truck Cargo, Base Minimums: 1 Vehicle ≥ \$100K | 2-3 Vehicles ≥ \$150K | 4-6 Vehicles ≥ \$250K | 7+ Vehicles ≥ \$300K

W-8BEN or W-9 Form

- ✓ The W-8BEN Form is a tax document for non-US taxpayers who earn US-sourced income, allowing you to claim exemption from mandatory withholdings.
- ✓ W-8BEN Form Rev. October 2021 version | Download a blank W-8BEN Form HERE.
- ✓ W-9 Form Rev. October 2018 version | Download a blank W-9 Form HERE.
- ✓ MUST be signed & dated.



Company-Level Background Check

- ✓ All Transporters MUST pass a background check conducted at the company owner or legal representative level.
- ✓ RunBuggy has partnered with American Recovery Association to perform this background check.
- ✓ American Recovery Association will email an invitation link to the company owner or legal representative from *customer-support@americanrecoveryassn.org*.
- ✓ This company-level background check MUST be passed to ensure access to the RunBuggy Marketplace and Orders.
